From a fairly modest start in Lloyds Court, with just seven members of staff, the business now employs 40 people locally, as part of an overall labour force of 360 in five offices in the UK and offices in Moscow and Abu Dhabi.

It was important for PRP to be identified with a city with a contemporary image and the conclusion was drawn that no other city in the UK could offer either the image or potential of Milton Keynes. Therefore, moving out of town was an option that was quickly dismissed.

Our mission is to produce places that are well-planned, well-designed and well-managed, so that the quality of life of residents can be greatly enhanced.

In view of this, Milton Keynes will have great relevance as the city expands and requires a further 50,000 houses in the next 20 years to accommodate residents, with accompanying schools, shops and workplaces.

PRP is already using its unique position to improve housing - and raise expectations - close to home, notably with the completion of Fresh@Medbourne, an exemplary new and award winning development.

So, to an extent, PRP is playing its part in building a living environment for the city that will make the city even more attractive.
